The Environmental and Water Resources Institute (EWRI) of the American Society of Civil Engineers' (ASCE) Committee on **Irrigation and Drainage** and the **Task Committee on the Use of Reclaimed Water for Irrigation of Turf and landscape Plants** is organizing a *Symposium on Reclaimed Water for Irrigation* at the **2020 World Environmental & Water Resources Congress**. On behalf of the Committees, we would like to invite you to participate at the Congress by submitting an abstract for the Symposium. The abstract may be submitted for a poster, a paper and or just an oral presentation.

The symposium will have a panel discussion followed by a session of papers on the issue. The panel will discuss the state of the art of water reuse for irrigation. Papers submitted by the deadline will be peer reviewed and accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings.
